### TOKYO/NAGOYA

An Obeya should always reflect the needs of the users rather than force its users into a certain fixed structure. A good Obeya is continually adapted and improved upon by the people involved. This main principle is part of today's programme.

**On Sunday** we will start in Tokyo and take the bullettrain together to Nagoya. There we will do a bit of easy sight-seeing to digest the jetlag. We will have a look at a temple and a Karakuri-clock in the neighbourhood. Karakuri refers to mechanisms using springs, gravity, magnetism to perform certain tasks.

Kaizen implementations which use these ideas are referred to as Karakuri Kaizen. Karakuri is still widely used in Japanese factories to make work easier, safer, better, etc. The idea is that workers actually build the workplace by themselves to make the work easier, safer and better. They adapt the environment to their needs, rather than the other way around.

### DAY 1 MON

VISIT TOYOTA ENGINEERING CORPORATION & MANAGEMENT INSTITUTE

**JUN 09** 





We visit the Toyota Engineering Corporation for a seminar and hands-on workshop on Toyota Way Management System and Toyota Production System. This will be an awesome experience where we learn Obeya principles and practice straight from the source.

**On Monday** the Toyota Engineering instructors have worked a lifetime at Toyota and were there in the early days when the Obeya concept was developed at Toyota. During the workshop we will use visualization concepts in a simple form such as a Yamazumi-chart to drive Kaizen of the assembly process. The assembly line simulation will be concluded by an Obeya style review of the participant's Kaizen achievements of the fan assembly.





DAY 2 TUE TOYOTA TPS IN ACTION

**JUN 10** 



Go Gemba time! Showcasing Toyota TPS Visual Management best practices and the roots of concepts such as Kata and ShuHaRi during a tea ceremony.

**On Tuesday** we will visit a supplier of Toyota to see how TPS is actually put into practice. We learn how Visual Management and Obeya are a natural part of the workfloor. In the afternoon it is time for tea. We engage in a traditional Japanese tea ceremony. The essence of the tea ceremony is all about the Art of Japanese Hospitality or Omotenashi in Japanese. Much more than just sipping tea...

It is one of the old Japanese traditions that lie at the roots of Obeya: People with different roles gather in one place to create a unique moment together in time and space. The purpose of a tea ceremony does not lie in the drinking of tea but rather in trying to walk the road to perfection. The Way of Tea cherishes interaction between people in order to be in the moment, to learn and grow together. Other ideas often heard in Lean and Agile such as Kata and ShuHaRi are directly connected to the tea ceremony.

### DAY 3 WED CONTINUOUS

A 5S FACTORY

ZEN TEMPLE

How an orderly, clean and safe work environment energizes employees and lays the foundations for visual management.

**On Wednesday** we head for Kyoto. After some sight-seeing we visit a Zen temple to meditate under guidance of a Zen priest. Zen meditation is about the essence of things and becoming a virtuous person. Consider Obeya as a practice to uncover the essence.

After a wonderful vegan lunch, served at the Zen temple, we're off to visit Nagahama Factory, a manufacturer of metal highprecision parts. Their continuous improvement efforts center on 5S (sift, sort, spic-and-span, standardize and stimulate) to create an orderly, clean and safe work environment. We will see how 5S in fact is a simple but very powerful tool for visual management and how this lies at the basis for any Obeya.
